- c. Lake Cornelia Alum Treatment completed, which will help address high phosphorus levels
- **d.** Non-profit projects 6 projects total on 'Current Projects Page', lead by Erica with support from Master Stewards doing outreach work.
- e. "Capital Improvement Projects" District pays fully because they probably would have been cost prohibitive for the non profit partners. Churches will take on upkeep after a couple years.
- f. Goldfish Project District awarded Hennepin County grant for goldfish management - people will track, keep watch and possibly start to catch. Still researching solutions.
 - Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Strategy District managers, staff, and consultants working on future rapid responses to new AIS infestations.
 - ii. Working with DNR, BWSR and Army Corps for permits and key partnerships.
- g. Call for educational suggestions with regard to Covid precautions. Have a mid summer meeting to discuss ideas further (ie virtual learning).
