WE ARE USING LESS SALT THIS WINTER TO PROTECT OUR CLEAN WATER!

DID YOU KNOW THAT 1 TSP OF SALT POLLUTES 5 GALLONS OF WATER?
EXCESS SALT DAMAGES BUILDINGS, HARMS PLANTS, ANIMALS AND FISHES
NOT TO MENTION INCREASES COMMON AREA MAINTENCE COSTS.

#1

SHOVEL

Always clear walkways before snow turns to ice and before you apply salt. The more snow you clear the less salt you'll need!

#2

SELECT

Salt doesn't melt ice when the pavement is below 15F, so please consider using sand for traction or an alternative de-icer!

#3

SCATTER

Only use where critical and please use 12-oz cup provided, it is enough salt to cover 10 sidewalk squares or a 20-foot driveway!

4

SWEEP

You can reuse the salt, sand and de-icer again and again, please help MN watersheds by sweeping and reusing winter materials!

SCOOP HOLDS ENOUGH TO TREAT 2 PARKING STALLS OR 10 SIDEWALK SQUARES!


