Program Updates

Education

Lizzy continues to create content for groundwater conservation, raising awareness on the importance of conserving groundwater in the home. She has also taken on more duties in the seed propagation experiment, and we are planning a class in late summer for the public on this topic. Other topics and classes for the Summer Education Series will be posted in the coming weeks. Lizzy has also continued to develop a new story map about the District's capital improvement projects. Finally, Lizzy has helped increase our social media presence, with over 150 new followers this year across all our platforms.

The raingarden has been prepared for planting, including adding compost and mulch into the basin. Stormdrain stenciling kits have been very popular this spring. Thanks to a few different Edina Girl Scout troops for marking the area around Lake Cornelia, Bredesen Park and Normandale Elementary. More kits will be loaned out through the rest of May. Some of the girls also adopted drains with their families through Hamline's Adopt a Drain program.

The Garlic Mustard Bust on April 24 along the Cardinal Creek wetland trail was very successful. We had nearly

20 people attend, and in two hours, we removed all the garlic mustard and narrow leaved bittercress in the newly cleared space. I also found many native woodland plants sprouting, which is a hopeful sign for the health of that space.

Adopt a Dock plates went out in April and May. These specialized plates will help volunteers monitor for zebra mussels in Bush, Bryant, and Cornelia Lakes.
