Program Updates

Education

School visits are wrapping up for the fall, with nearly 250 students, parents, and teachers engaged in learning about water and water quality. Many students expressed interest in participating in the Adopt a Drain program. I visited students in their classrooms to teach about the water cycle and water quality, as well as macroinvertebrate id (pictured here at Highlands Elementary). I also led a field trip for students of Glen Lake Elementary at Lone Lake Park in Minnetonka.

I also worked with second graders at Normandale Hills Elementary in Bloomington to use their new raingarden in their lessons on seed dispersal, pollinators, and plant ID. All told, our education program has reached students in six schools most of our member cities.

Outreach





I attended multiple outreach events, including the EV Expo at Oak Grove Presbyterian Church. There, I promoted our grants program, and talked about the raingarden installed last year through our partnership in the Non-Profit BMP Project.

I also attended the Bloomington Farmer's Market in September, again to talk about our habitat restoration grants, and the benefits of native plants to water quality.

Lastly, I shared a table with RPBCWD at the Eden Prairie Volunteer Fair.
