# **Program Updates**

### **Adult Education**

The Sustainable Lawns workshop on May 28<sup>th</sup> was very popular, and despite some audio difficulties, went very smoothly for our first public partner webinar. Out of nearly 100 RSVPs, about 50 tuned in to the webinar.

### **K12 Education**

Megan, Erica, and I are working on a raingarden project with students from Normandale Hills Elementary. Student volunteers from 3-5<sup>th</sup> grades will be helping create a budget and planting plan for the raingarden space that currently exists on site.

### Outreach

Megan and I continue to work on outreach materials, including scheduling blog posts for our website, and social media posts for facebook and Instagram. Megan is also working on developing lake fact sheets for public distribution.

I am working on an interpretive sign for the Edina Streambank Restoration project and road signs for creek crossings around the District.

### **Citizen Advisory Committee**

The CAC met on May 27<sup>th</sup>, so members can attend the Sustainable Lawns workshop. Members presented on the Cost Share Grants awarded this year, as well as a presentation on other best management practices in stormwater retention.

A crew of volunteers led by Ember K and Bob P have continued work on removing invasive species from the Cardinal Creek Wetland Trail behind Discovery Point. They have enlisted the help of metro Master Water Stewards and have nearly cleared the garlic mustard and bittercress from the open part of the trail. We are working in partnership with them and the City of Eden Prairie to plant replacement seed this fall.
