Program Updates

Education

The Friday Fireplace Reads event has reached around 100 people each event. It received good feedback from attendees. The event will finish on the last Friday in April. The rest of April will be quite busy in terms of Education and Outreach. Lizzy and I will be presenting at multiple schools this month (virtually). We will also be hosting a Garlic Mustard Bust on April 24th in the Cardinal Creek restoration area.

Groundwater conservation videos have been created and posted, thanks to help from our CAC members and MWS.

Lizzy and I have been promoting the JR Watershed Explorer book; we filmed an instructional video, and will be partnering with Edina community education to get more books out.

Partnerships

Normandale Hills Raingarden

Over the past year, I have been working with staff and parent volunteers at Normandale Hills Elementary school in Bloomington on their raingarden. We are now getting ready to prep the garden and plant in the middle of May. Teachers will use this raingarden in their lessons on phenology, plants, pollinators, life sciences, and other subjects.

Raingarden maintenance video

I partnered with the cities of Bloomington, Minnetonka, and Eden Prairie to update a raingarden maintenance video. We worked with Jill Zimmerman to make these updates. These videos will be used in future raingarden maintenance classes around the watershed.

PUPPP

Lizzy and I are partnering with the city of Minnetonka to do some popup poop prevention programs. We will be in person, on popular trails and parks talking to people about picking up dog waste while they walk their dogs.

I have been helping Riley Purgatory Bluff Creek WD interview for their Education and Outreach Coordinator position.

I will be sitting on the Edina Climate Action Plan team from April through September, helping make a Climate Action Plan for that city with multiple other entities.
