Program Updates

Education

The raingarden maintenance class was very well received. This class kicked off our Summer Education Series. Other activities in the series include a bike tour in July, and a seed propagation class in August. The Education team is investigating how to make our programs a hybrid, so that people can attend future programs online or in person.

Outreach

Lizzy is maintaining a display at Untiedts garden center in Eden Prairie, focusing on cost share grants and benefits of native plants. We will be replenishing materials throughout the summer.

I am in the beginning stages of designing a new interactive, tabletop salt display, and working with designers now. This display will be funded in part by the donations in memory of Walter Levesque.

Normandale Hills Raingarden

5th graders planted nearly 400 flowers in the raingarden, and placed their individually designed stepping stones on the path. Volunteers will be caring for the raingarden over the summer, and I will continue to work with teachers to incorporate it into their lessons in the next school year.

I have been working with partners to coordinate the program in the cities of Minnetonka, Bloomington, Eden Prairie. We will continue to participate in this program with metal signs in some cities, and chloroplast signs in others. Drains continue to be adopted throughout the watershed.
