Surly Brewing and Towerside District Stormwater Park, Minneapolis

Meet in Surly Brewing first floor beer hall: 520 Malcolm Ave. SE

Wonder how stormwater would be handled in a neighborhood designated as innovative? Come learn about stormwater management at Surly Brewery and the Towerside Innovation District, a 370-acre area in Minneapolis and Saint Paul with a bustling economy along the Green Line LRT. You'll get a guided tour of two stormwater treatment systems in Towerside, conducted by the system designers:


- **Surly Brewing:** This brownfields redevelopment manages stormwater using filtration practices integrated into the industrial brewery setting. Additionally, you'll learn about the extensive brownfields cleanup and water sourcing for beer production.
- **Towerside District Stormwater System and Park:** This system collects stormwater from 8 acres of new development, treats runoff in a park-like setting, and stores the stormwater for future reuse.

The tour will start with a short presentation at Surly Brewing, followed by a 90-minute tour of the innovative stormwater management systems. We will walk approximately 1 mile, so you may want to wear comfortable walking shoes. Following the tour at 4 p.m., we will enjoy a happy hour at Surly Brewing in the main beer hall. This event and tour will happen rain or shine, so dress for the weather.
