This program has been changed to the Minnesota Water Stewards by the Freshwater Society to make the program more inclusive.

Citizen Advisory Committee

The CAC met on Sep 24 to share their experiences from the Salt Symposium, discuss ideas for the State of the Waters event, and discuss the photo contest and new online voting procedure. 9 out of 11 CAC members voted on their top 12-15 pictures in each season, and staff then arranged the pictures in the most pleasing way for the 2021 calendar. We will once again be working with the Design Company to design and print the calendar.



Cardinal Creek Buckthorn project

For the past few years, volunteers have been working to clear buckthorn and other invasive plants from the City of Eden Prairie trail adjacent to Discovery Point. Volunteers and District staff prepped and seeded the site on September 30th. Staff and volunteers will assess the seed growth in spring, and organize needed weed pulls and herbicides as needed on a yearly basis.
