Program Updates

Education

The Sustainable and Lo-mow Turf Workshops were popular, with over 30 people attending each one. Jon Trappe, from the UMN Extension Soil Office presented. Paul Erdmann's presentation, Bring Nature Home was also very successful. Our Level 2 Smart Salting workshop had good attendance, despite it being off season. Lastly, the first Art in Nature program (Ojibwa Block Prints at Lone Lake Park) had great attendance. Native artist Gordon Coons walked people through painting their own picture using carved wooden blocks.

Outreach

Gael presented on water saving practices to the newly formed green team of Dell Co in Eden Prairie in June. Pollinator Field Day will be on July 11 at Lone Lake Park. The District will have a station on macroinvertebrates and will bring handouts on District programs.

Nick and Gael had a table at the Bloomington Farmer's Market on July 7th. We brought the AIS Junior Inspector kit to talk about invasive species, as well as preparations for the Normandale Lake Project.
