Description

Apply “No dumping” stormdrain markers to the curbs next to stormdrains in your community, and pass out educational doorhangers at houses in the areas where the stormdrains are marked.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Meet with District staff to discuss marking procedure
- Pick up and drop off stormdrain marking kit from District
- Define a neighborhood area that you would like to mark
- Apply stormdrain markers to each stormdrain in the area
- Answer questions of passersby and neighbors, as appropriate
- Follow all traffic rules, and be aware of your surroundings

Qualifications

- Interest in water quality stewardship and engaging with the community

Time Commitment and Schedule

2-3 hours per marking event. Flexible schedule.

Materials required from volunteer

- Transportation to and from site

Materials provided by District

- Stormdrain marking kit and training
- Map of stormdrains in designated area
- Safety vests and traffic cones
- Doorhangers
