



Wetland Buffer Markers

The Nine Mile Creek Watershed District's rules list requirements for marking wetland buffers. This fact sheet is a guide to meeting those requirements (rules section 3.4.5).

ALL wetland buffer markers must:

- Be permanent (e.g. resistant to weather conditions)
- Have text approved by District



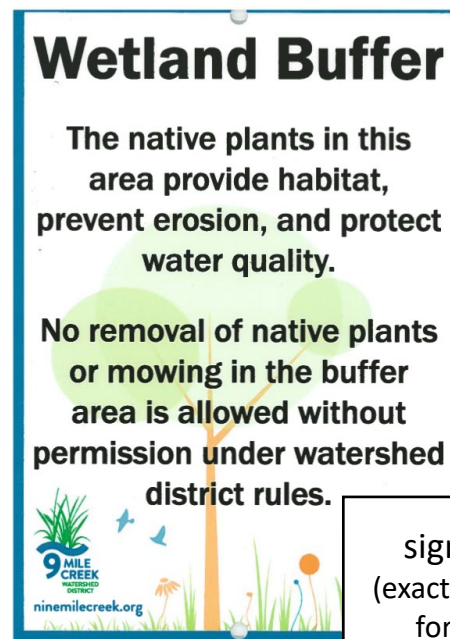
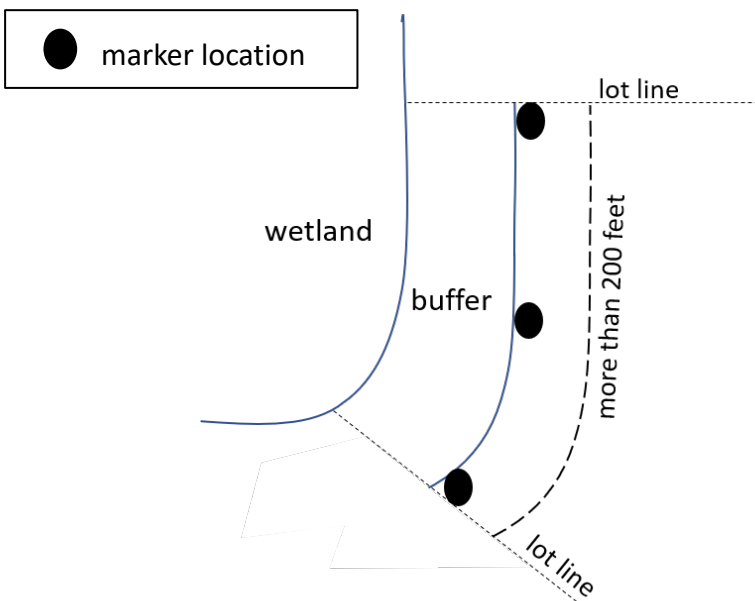
In addition, for buffers on **private land**, markers must:

- Be free standing
- Be placed at upland edge
- At least one on each lot line
- Have no more than 200 feet between signs on one lot



In addition, for buffers on **public or right-of-way land**, choose an option:

- OPTION 1: Monument(s) flush to ground
- OPTION 2: Breakaway marker(s) of durable material
- OPTION 3: Follow private requirements (left)
